### **Message from Administration**

Welcome Back! We are really looking forward to the 2020-21 school year! Although some things will look different this year, what hasn't changed is that staff have been very busy preparing classroom spaces and engaging learning materials, eagerly waiting for the arrival of your kids! We currently have 568 students attending Blueberry School!

We have many Alberta Health Services and <u>Alberta Education</u> protocols that we are following to keep students and staff safe. The best place to keep up to date on our protocols is the <u>Parkland School Division Website</u>. Among these protocols is our <u>mask policy</u> for all staff and students grades 4-9. Mask wearing for students in grades K-3 is supported, but not required at this time.

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19 at home, families should use the <u>AHS Online Assessment Tool</u> to determine if their child can attend school. If your child develops symptoms at school, that are not attributed to a preexisting condition, administration will follow AHS procedures.

When entering the building for an appointment, visitors will be asked to complete the AHS COVID-19 screening test as part of our <u>Visitor Entry Protocol</u>. This is another way we can work together in tracking who enters the building.

We would like to welcome new students, staff and families to the Blueberry School Community. Please help us welcome our new head secretary, Mrs. Cynthia Wozny! As well, we'd like to welcome back Mr. Ewasiuk, who will be joining our JH team part-time.

### POWERSCHOOL PARENT PORTAL - IMPORTANT

The PowerSchool Parent Portal is a valuable tool for parents, giving them access to student attendance, report cards, and online fee payments. You can also change your address and contact information from this portal. If you are new to Blueberry School, or have not yet created an account, your child will bring home a paper with their "unique" username and password. You will need this when you are creating your new account, or adding a child to your current account, on PowerSchool. It is important that we have the most current information on file. Please take a few minutes to log into your PowerSchool–Parent Portal account (<a href="https://powerschool.psd70.ab.ca/public/">https://powerschool.psd70.ab.ca/public/</a>) and make any necessary changes under the Family Information tab. If there are changes to Guardianship/Custody, please contact the school office.

### **School Fees**

School fees will be added to your child's Powerschool account shortly as they are under review. Any credits from the 2019/20 school year will be applied to 2020/21. They can't be paid through the app—only through the actual website. Fees will be posted to the website shortly. At that time, if you prefer, you can print the fee sheet and return it to the school with your cheque (made out to PSD70) or cash. Payment plans are also available on this site.

# Orange Shirt Day - Every Child Matters September 30, 2020



Why Orange Shirts? Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission (SJM) residential school commemoration event held in Williams Lake, BC, Canada. It grew out of Phyllis' story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission, and it has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential schools happening annually.

The date was chosen because it is the time of year in which children were taken from their homes to residential schools. Please wear an orange shirt on Monday, September 30th as schools and communities come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come.

### **Administering Medication & Pre-Existing Medical Conditions**



If your child requires medication during the school day, it is Division Policy that a signed consent form be completed in advance. This form requires a physician's signature. Contact the office for a form or further information. All medication brought to school must be kept at the office, and will only be accepted in the original clearly labeled bottle/box. Only **prescription** 

**medication** will be dispensed at the office. Please ask the pharmacist for a second labeled bottle to be kept at school.

**All medication that was left at the school in June has been disposed of.** Note – Medication will not be dispensed from the office for field trips. Parents are responsible for providing extra medication on field trip days if necessary. Students that may need an Epi-Pen are required to supply an Epi-Pen for storage in the school office and the required forms must be completed. If necessary an additional Epi-Pen can be kept by the student.

Please assist us to gather information that would be helpful for staff to be aware of by completing any and all pre-existing medical conditions for your child(ren). Please submit one form per child, if you have not already provided the school with details.

### **BLANKET STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

Our school board is offering you the opportunity to voluntarily purchase student accident insurance through iA Financial Group.

This insurance provides protection against unexpected costs arising from accidental injuries. The program is especially valuable for families who:

- do not have medical or dental plans,
- have limited plans, as it may help supplement health and dental benefits, or
- have active children who enjoy sports and outdoor activities.

It has a selection of plans to suit most budgets. Benefits include coverage for:

- The full school year (September to September), 24 hours a day, while at home and in school;
- Expenses that are often limited or not covered by private or group insurance plans, or Provincial Health Insurance Plans, such as ambulance, physiotherapy, private tutoring, counselling, and much more;
- Injury-related dental treatment (including future dental treatment up to age 26);
- Out-of-province or country emergency medical expenses.

If your address changes during the school year, your Accident Insurance plan is transferable from school to school, anywhere in Canada. See Parkland School Division's website for more information and to apply:



### PARKING LOT SAFETY

Reminder that there is NO PARKING in the <u>drop-off areas</u> in the morning from 7:40 - 8:00 am and from 2:20 - 2:50 pm daily.



Please be mindful of students and staff who are trying to cross the parking lot to get to and from the school. Our front parking lot goes in a "one-way" direction. If you are dropping off your children, please go around to the drop off area, and then continue around the parking lot to exit.
